- 2. Worship. Archbishop John Holder will spend his last Sunday as Bishop of the Diocese and Archbishop of the Church of the Province of the West Indies in the Cathedral. He will preside and preach at the 9 o'clock Sung Eucharist on Sunday, February 25, 2018 when his relationship with the cathedral will be celebrated. All are invited to attend this historic service of worship.

#### **DIOCESAN NEWS**

2. Bishop's Retirement: Members would be aware, that The Most Rev'd & Dr. the Hon. John W. D. Holder will retire as Bishop of the Diocese of Barbados and consequently as Archbishop of the Province of the Church in the West Indies, on February 28, 2018, having attained the age of 70 years. The following may be noted:

#### Regulation C3 "Of the Cathedral Chapter", 12

I. Whenever the See be vacant, the guardianship of the spiritualities belongs to the Dean and Chapter. The Chapter shall meet within seven days of a vacancy and shall appoint a person who need not be a member of the Chapter to administer the Diocese during the vacancy. The Archbishop shall be notified forthwith of the name and address of the Diocesan Administrator.

#### Regulation C1 "Of The Bishop", 3

II. When a vacancy in the See has been formally notified by the Archbishop according to the provisions of the Canons of the Church in the Province of the West Indies, the Diocesan Administrator appointed in accordance with Regulation C3:12 shall within fourteen days summon a meeting of the Synod Council and the Council shall forthwith instruct the Secretary to summon the members of Synod for the purpose of choosing a Bishop for the Diocese. Twenty-one days' notice of the time and place of the meeting shall be given.

#### THE FIRST SUNDAY IN LENT

FIRST READING: GENESIS 9:8-17

Comment: "The rainbow, sign of God's covenant"

Our Hebrew Scripture lesson tells of God's promise to Noah and to future generations never again to flood all the earth. God establishes this covenant with a sign—the rainbow that is seen in the storm clouds. This covenant is made with the whole creation. It signifies God's purpose to preserve and save the world, not to destroy it.

#### Psalm 25:1-9

A prayer for forgiveness and guidance and an expression of trust in the Lord.

SECOND READING: (The Epistle) 1 Peter 3:18-22

#### Comment: "Saved through water"

This reading from the New Testament speaks of the significance of Christ's death and resurrection. In the story of Noah's salvation a prefigurement of our own salvation through the water of baptism is perceived. Portions of this letter are thought to have been originally composed for use in a service of baptism and Eucharist on the eve of Easter. Such a purpose would explain the association of the themes of Christ's death, baptism, and his triumphal resurrection. It is uncertain who is meant by the spirits to whom Christ preached after his death, but this activity may signify God's intention for the salvation of all.

THE HOLY GOSPEL: Mark 1:9-15

Comment: "The temptation of Jesus"

The gospel is the story of Jesus' baptism followed by his temptation in the wilderness by Satan and his proclamation of the coming kingdom of God. As Jesus comes up from the water, the Holy Spirit descends like a dove and a voice from heaven tells him that he is the beloved Son. The Spirit then guides him out into the wilderness, where ancient Israel also met its temptations. Here Jesus has his first encounter with Satan, and then goes forth proclaiming the nearing reign of God: "Repent, and believe in the good news."
