DAY OF PENTECOST ~ WHITSUNDAY

First Reading: Acts 2:1-21

Comment: *"Filled with the Spirit"*
This lesson tells **the story of the Holy Spirit filing the apostles and empowering them to share the message of the gospel with people of different languages.** Clearly this was a most dramatic moment in the life of the early church, an experience described in terms of wind and fire. From this time forward the might works of God done in Jesus will be told to all the peoples of the earth, crossing barriers of language and culture.

Psalm 104:25-35, 37
The psalm describes the wonders of the world created and renewed by the Lord's Spirit.

SECOND READING (The Epistle): Romans 8:14-17

Comment: *"The Spirit makes us children of God"*
In this lesson, we hear that **when we are moved by God's Spirit, we become God's children and heirs with Christ.** The Spirit makes this experience possible by prompting our lips to call upon God as Father with the same Aramaic word (*Abba*) that Jesus used. This new relationship means that we are no longer required to be led by baser instincts. Our heritage is life, while we must also learn to share Christ's sufferings.

THE HOLY GOSPEL: John 15:26-27; 16:4b-15

Comment: *"Christ sends the Spirit of truth"*
In our Gospel, **Jesus tells his disciples that his going away will mean the coming of the Advocate, the Holy Spirit who will guide them into all truth.** The Counsellor-Spirit will bring true judgement into the world. Everything the Spirit declares will have been received from Jesus, even as all which the Father has belongs to Jesus. The Spirit, then, reveals Jesus who himself has made the Father known.
