The Second Sunday after The Epiphany

First Reading: Isaiah 49:1-7 Comment: "The servant brings light to the nations"

In our Hebrew scripture lesson the servant of the Lord reflects movingly on his mission-its sorrows and frustrations-and God's high calling and promise to be with him. The servant is sometimes thought to be an historical individual, or is understood as an idealization of Israel. This song was probably composed as the exiles from Jerusalem were preparing to return to their devasted city. Despite appearances, the Lord will make this servant a light to the nations.

Psalm 40:1-12

A prayer for deliverance and a song of thanksgiving to God who has saved the Lord's servant from great troubles and made it possible to sing God's praise.

SECOND READING (The Epistle): 1 Corinthians 1:1-9 **Comment** *"Paul's greeting to the church at Corinth"*

In this lesson Paul greets the members of the new Christian community in Corinth and offers thanksgiving for their growth in Christ. He is writing from Ephesus some months after his first stay with the Corinthians, and he will shortly be concerned with many of their problems and questions. Now he reminds these disciples of their high calling and expresses his gratitude for their spiritual enrichment.

THE HOLY GOSPEL: John 1:29-42 **Comment:** "Christ revealed as the Lamb of God"

In our Gospel passage, John the Baptist declares who Jesus is. The next day two of John's followers become disciples of Jesus. One of these disciples is Andrew, who then brings his brother Simon Peter. John has led them to understand that Jesus is God's chosen one, the servant on whom God's spirit rests. He is the Lamb of God who will be a sacrifice for the sins of the world.
