The Eighth Sunday After Pentecost

First Reading: 1 Kings 3:5-12

Comment: "Solomon's prayers for wisdom"

In the opening lesson, King Solomon pleases the Lord by requesting an understanding mind with which to govern the people. God appears to Solomon in a dream shortly after he has come to the throne of his father David. Solomon not only wishes the skill to rule but the wisdom to do it justly, distinguishing between good and evil. God grants him this and much more, and Solomon will become famous both for his wisdom and the splendour of his kingdom.

Psalm 119:129-136

The psalmist continues to praise God's commandments and asks for guidance and the Lord's justice.

Second Reading (The Epistle): Romans 8:26-39

Comment "Nothing can separate us from God's love"

In this lection, Paul expresses his great confidence that God is for us, making love known to humankind through the sacrifice of the Son and the help of the Spirit. The Spirit pleads with God for us, interceding when words fail. We learn that God works for good with those called according to God's purpose. Nothing, therefore, can separate us from the love of One who did not withhold from us the divine Son. Neither mortal distress nor supernatural power can separate us from such love.

THE HOLY GOSPEL: Matthew 13:31-33, 44-52,

Comment: "Parables of the reign of heaven"

Our Gospel is five of Jesus's short parables: the mustard seed, the leaven, the hidden treasure, the priceless pearl, and the net. They suggest how the action of God's reign is realised. What seems insignificant is suddenly of great importance. It is like a marvelous gift which one seizes upon joyfully and for which all else is willingly sacrificed. The kingdom takes all kinds, and the sorting out must await the end. Wise servants will recognise treasure both old and new.
