as thou hast been thou for ever wilt be.

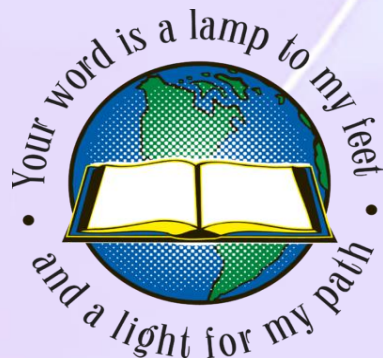

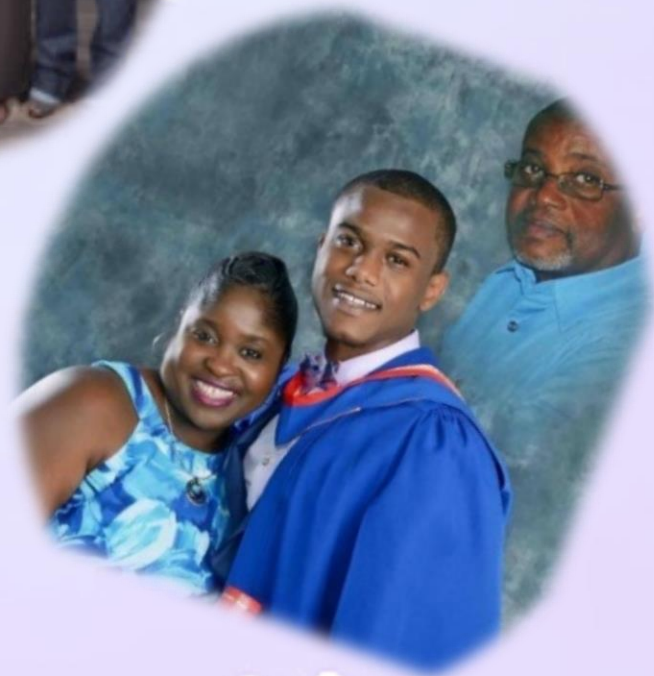


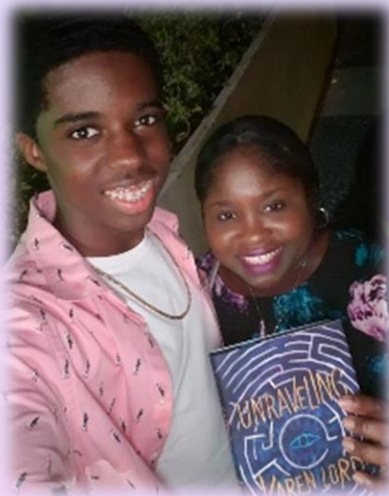
